

Write Your Story Outline

“Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story...” Psalm 107:2

1. Start journaling – hind sight is clear sight. Journal every day so you can recognize the big moments that may, initially, feel like just another day.
2. Take the self-assessment test. Understand your “aha” moments and include them in your story.
3. Despite difficulties in life, you and your readers can live a redeemed life, too. Remember, all of our stories start with “Once upon a time...” but our stories should always end with “Happily ever after” *with Jesus*. When others read your story, they should want to read their bible and pursue more of God. It is the “why” of writing your story: **Write so heaven is different!**
